It's been a busy year already. We've had 11 retreats plus 5 workdays since January 1st.

Summer staffing positions have been filled and preparations for staff training week are almost complete.

We believe so much in the power of prayer, that we would like to ask you to be praying for the following:

1. Our staff would clearly share the gospel to each camper
2. Safety for staff and campers
3. The camp speakers would clearly present God's word
4. Campers' hearts would be receptive
5. Safety for parents/guardians as they drop off & pick up campers

The dining hall renovation and expansion project is moving along and racing to get the kitchen and the old part of the dining hall

completed by May 20th.

The new addition will follow within a few weeks afterwards, Lord willing.

It's been amazing to watch God through His church and people supply for the much needed renovation.

To date, God has provided \$286,000 of the \$406,000 needed. That means we only need another \$120,000 (plus any overages) to complete the funding for the project!!!

I am humble by the generosity of so many churches and individuals in giving to support the ministry here at Camp Bethel. I can't begin to express my gratitude. Thank you.

We are planning a Grand Opening to celebrate God's provisions for the new dining hall, Saturday, August 19th. So, mark your calendar for this awesome event. Come and see the newly renovated dining hall. We would love to see you! Watch our

If additional funds are still needed to pay off the building, the Grand Opening celebration will also be a fundraiser to help complete the needed funding.

**WOW, GOD! JUST WOW!**




