Camp Bethel has been serving youth for the past 82 years as a Christ centered youth camp and retreat center. We exist to share the gospel, and to encourage believers to grow in their relationship with our Lord and Savior.

Camp Bethel is looking for young men & women who have completed High School, have a founded relationship with our Lord, Jesus Christ, and agree with our statement of faith as summer counselors. If you are currently a senior in high school and will graduate this spring, you are eligible, or if you are currently in college and between the ages of 18-22.

All counselors will need to arrive on Monday, May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026, around 3pm for the start of a week of staff training. The summer camp season ends July 25<sup>th</sup>, approx. 8pm. You will need to leave by 10 am the morning of the 26<sup>th</sup> before our next group arrives. You will have one week off from the afternoon of June 27<sup>th</sup> through July 5<sup>th</sup> to rest up for the second half of summer. Typically, the staff go someplace together to hangout and rest off-site during break week. More info on what that will look like after you get here.

Even though we consider all positions as volunteers, you will receive a \$250 stipend (minus taxes) for the week of staff training, and each of the 7 weeks of summer camps, as our way of saying thank you for serving with us. Because we consider this position as a short-term summer mission position, we encourage staff to raise additional support/funding, if needed, through their local church.

Each Monday will start with a staff meeting at 9 am. Camper check-in is at 2pm, but you can expect campers to arrive early. Campers leave after the 10 am closing ceremony on Saturday. You can expect long, extreme fun, and challenging days. Your weekend starts after lunch Saturday. If you decide to leave campus Saturday, you will need to be back no later than 8 pm Sunday.

Each week of camp is by grade groups. First week is 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>, then 6<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup>, break week, 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> boys & 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> girls. We are an outdoor camp, so you can expect being outside a lot.

As a counselor, you will be assigned a cabin each week, and be responsible for your campers until they leave on Saturday.

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## Summer Staff Information Schedule

- Arrive May 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026 - around 3 pm to start a week of staff training.
  - Training will include but not limited to the following:
    - First Aid, CPR & AED.
    - Camp Policies & Procedures.
    - Learn the different activities we will do at camp.
    - Team building.
    - Signs of child abuse and how to report.
    - Love & Logic.
    - Staff day trip.
    - Learn to plan a Bible studies.
    - Learn to share the Gospel and practice sharing the Gospel.
    - Evening Chapel services.
    - Develop and plan banquet night skits.
    - Misc.
- 4 weeks of camp
- Break week this year will be the afternoon of June 27<sup>th</sup>- the evening of July 5<sup>th</sup> (will need to be back by 8pm). Staff must leave the facility for the break week for refreshment. Staff will normally do a trip together on their own (not camp sponsored), but you will have the freedom to do what you desire during your time off.
- 3 more weeks of camp.
- Summer ends and you're free to leave Sunday morning, July 26<sup>th</sup>.
- \$250 stipend for 8 weeks, total \$2,000 (approx. \$1847 after taxes).
- Room and Board provided except for break week. If you leave camp on the weekends, you will need to provide for your own expenses off site.
- Counselors are responsible for their cabin from the time campers arrive on Monday until they leave on Saturday.
- Summer staff must provide their own Health Insurance.
- You will need to bring bedding, sleeping bag (campouts), toiletries, towel, clothing, bug spray, laundry detergent, laundry softener, etc. We have a laundry facility.
- Seasonal staff (Summer staff) are considered volunteer missionaries serving their Lord and Savior here at Camp Bethel for the summer.
