Camp Bethel has been serving Wyoming and beyond for the past 78 years as a Christ centered youth camp and retreat center. We exist to share the gospel, and to encourage believers to grow in their relationship with our Lord and Savior.

Camp Bethel is looking for young men & women who have completed High School, have a founded relationship with our Lord, Jesus Christ, and agree with our statement of faith as summer counselors. If you are currently a senior in high school and will graduate this spring, you are eligible, or if you are currently in college and between the ages of 18-24.

All counselors will need to arrive Monday, May 27th 2024 around 3pm for the start of a week of staff training. The summer season ends August 4th, approx. 3pm. You will have one week off from the afternoon of June 29th through July 7th to rest up for the second half of summer. During this week off, we usually have a foster care group here and no one is allowed to be onsite during this time due to their security issues. Typically, the staff go someplace together to hangout and rest off-site while the foster care group is here. More info on what that will look like after you get here.

Even though we consider all positions as volunteers, you will receive a \$150 stipend (minus taxes) for the week of staff training, and each of the 8 weeks of summer camps, as our way of saying thank you for serving with us. Because we consider this position as a short-term summer mission position, we encourage staff to raise additional support/funding, if needed, through their local church.

Each Monday will start with a staff meeting at 10 am. Camper check-in is at 2pm, but you can expect campers to arrive early. Campers leave after the 10 am closing ceremony on Saturday. You can expect long, extreme fun, and challenging days. Your weekend starts after lunch Saturday. If you decide to leave campus Saturday, you will need to be back no later than 8 pm Sunday.

Each week of camp is by grade groups. First week is 5th-6th, then 6th-7th, 7th-8th, 8th-9th, break week, 9th-11th, 10th-12th, 3rd-5th boys & 3rd-5th girls. Every two weeks, we change the schedule and activities so they are grade related. We are an outdoor camp, so you can expect being outside a lot.

As a counselor, you will be assigned a cabin each week, and be responsible for your campers until they leave on Saturday.

- Arrive May 27th, 2024 around 3 pm to start a week of staff training.
 - Training will include but not limited to the following:
 - First Aid, CPR & AED.

- 4 weeks of camp
- Break week this year will be June 29th- July 9th. Staff must leave the facility for the break week for refreshment. We will have a foster care group that will use the camp for a foster care kids camp here during break week. The groups security will not allow our staff to be on location due to security issues). Staff will do a trip together on their own (not camp sponsored), but you will have the freedom to do what you desire during your time off.
- 4 more weeks of camp.
- Summer ends and your free to leave Sunday morning, Aug 4th.
- \$150 stipend for 9 weeks, total \$1,350 (approx. \$1070.55 after taxes).
- Room and Board provided except for break week. If you leave the camp on the weekends, you will need to provide your own meals off site.
- Counselors are responsible for their cabin from the time campers arrive on Monday until they leave on Saturday.
- Seasonal staff (Summer staff) must provide their own Health Insurance.
- Seasonal staff (Summer staff) are considered volunteers serving their Lord and Savior here at Camp Bethel for the summer.
