This summer we had another record breaking attendance of 717 campers! The exciting part was, 113 of them were un-churched youth who were invited by their friends to come to camp.



What's New

God has opened some doors for us to add another option to our "High Adventures" Activities. In the past, for an additional \$20 a camper could select Rappelling and Rock Wall Climbing.

Next summer we'll be adding an "Antelope Butte Mountain" option to our High Adventures. If a camper selects this option, camp will transport them to the Antelope Butte Mountain Recreation Area where the camper will ride the ski chair lift to the top of Antelope Butte Mountain and then hike down with camp staff.

At this time, a camper can only select Rappelling/Rock wall or Antelope Butte Mountain for the week, not both. This is an extra \$20 option located under the High Adventures Activities.

We hope to allow campers in the near future the option to select both the Rappelling/Rock Wall and Antelope Butte Mountain High Adventure, but for this summer, only one or the other can be selected if they wish to pay the additional \$20 fee.

Camp also purchased 20 new kayaks last year but we're only able to use them a few times due to weather. Next summer, we hope to be able to use them more.

Next summer we'll be changing some of the activities we do for each grade group. This way there will be something new to look forward to each year a camper advances to the next group level.

Finally, I am excited to announce that the Antelope Butte Mountain Recreation Area has offered Camp Bethel's rental groups some really nice discounts to go Nordic or Alpine/Snowboard skiing while staying here. I will be sending out a letter explaining our special pricing here soon to all our current rental groups.

We do praise God that we only have a couple of open weekends available for booking this winter. God has been keeping the camp busy, and we truly praise Him for the work He's doing here at Camp Bethel.
